

NEW DCP INITIATIVES: MASTERS RECRUITING SCHOLARSHIPS

For the 2017-2018 academic year, up to 10 DCP scholarships will be awarded to support the recruitment of high caliber, full-time students who are considered admissible (or have been admitted) to one of the master's degree programs in the college. Each scholarship will be \$10,000 for one year, with the possibility of renewal for a second consecutive year (subject to satisfactory progress).

Submission Process: Graduate coordinators in the college's academic units, in consultation with their unit head and graduate faculty, will submit up to four scholarship applications. Each proposal (500-word limit) will outline the following: (1) qualifications and aptitude of the applicant(s) including GRE test scores (where applicable), (2) alignment with the unit or program's strategic focus (3) proposed faculty advisor, and (4) potential for academic and professional success.

Priority will be given to those students pursuing the Masters as a terminal degree, and who demonstrate a strong aptitude for graduate work.

For full consideration, all proposals should be submitted by 5 p.m. ET on **February 17, 2017** to Theresa Sanchez (tsanchez@dcp.ufl.edu). Please include '**DCP Masters Scholarship**' on the subject line. Funding decisions will be made by **March 3, 2017**.
