

NEW DCP INITIATIVES: DCP TEACHING ASSISTANTSHIPS

one-term teaching appointments

The purpose of these one-time, one-term assistantships are to support the development of teaching skills and experiences in graduate students, who are enrolled full-time in DCP terminal master's or doctoral programs. All incoming or currently enrolled graduate students will be eligible for consideration.

This program will support students, who are interested in pursuing an academic career in any of the disciplines within the College of Design, Construction and Planning, and would benefit by having the opportunity to teach a live undergraduate course in the college under the supervision of an experienced faculty member. DCP will award up to four of these teaching assistantships (FTE .25 for one term: fall, spring, or summer) for the academic year 2017-2018.

Submission Process: Graduate coordinators from interested DCP programs will assemble up to two submissions from their respective units. Each short proposal (500-word limit) will outline the following: 1) candidate's merits and potential for professional development, and 2) course description, course contact hours, projected enrollment, and faculty supervisor for the teaching assistant.

For full consideration, all proposals should be submitted by 5 p.m. ET on **February 3, 2017** to Theresa Sanchez (tsanchez@dcp.ufl.edu). Please include 'DCP 1-Term TA' on the subject line. Funding decisions will be made by **February 24, 2017**.
