








## **Colored Cemetery**

There are I 20 markers in the Colored Cemetery on Mill Hill, traditionally used for the burial of people of color, as of July 2004.

The first mention of the Mill Hill cemetery was in the Nantucket Registry of Deeds, Proprietors Records, Vol. 1, p. 228, 29th day of fifth month, 1805: "Voted that the Black People may fence in one acre of land



"Voted that the Black People may fence in one acre of land where their Burying Place is and that the lot layers measure it to them." 3rd day of sixth month, 1805: "Then measured where the Black People's Burying Place is: from a rock to the southwest of where they have buried eastward 12 1/2 rods; from thence northward 12 1/2 rods; from thence westward 12 1/2 rods; from thence to the southward 12 1/2 rods to said rock; containing about one acre which was granted to the Black People to fence in for a Burying Place by the Proprietors as by a vote on record will appear."


### MISCELLANY.

Other nations have gathered more laurels in the field of blood; other nations have twined more garlands and sung louder praise for their poets and erators and philosophers; but where has romantic courage and adventurous skill been more strikingly exhibited? STABBING. Yesterday morning, John Peters, a black hair-dresser was brought before Josiah Hussey Esq. to answer to a complaint for stabbing one Stephen Hill, another black, on the night previous, at a place south of the town, called Guinea hill,the residence 'chiefly of colored people. His defence was, that the attack was commenced by the other party. It appeared that three several stabs were inflicted by means of a large jack-knife in the hands of Peters-in the shoulder, the breast, and near the groin: the latter, it was at first apprehended, would prove mortal; but we since learn that Hill will probably recover. An occurrence of this nature is so extremely rare in this place, that much excitement was naturally created by the circumstance. After as full an investigation of the affair. as could be had at that time, the magistrate ordered the offender to be committed to prison, for further examination on Monday next.

• This racist rhetoric was pervasive and entrenched in the opinion that if African Americans could no longer be enslaved then they should leave the island altogether.











