- Must have the three critical tracking courses (see back of form, courses designated with *)

NOTE: Please be aware meeting minimum qualifications does not guarantee acceptance to the limited access upper division degree program. All student applications are competitively ranked and only the top 60 students each Fall and Spring semesters are accepted into the upper division program. Competitive upper division admission GPA defers from the required UF tracking GPA. Meeting just the required minimum tracking GPA doesn't make you a competitive applicant for the upper division program. The five year average for upper division admissions is a 3.37 GPA. The following GPA is suggested each semester to be a competitive applicant for upper division. (Sem. 1-2.50, Sem. 2-2.75, Sem. 3-3.0, Sem. 4-3.50). You can only apply to upper division twice. Must submit an application to enter into the limited access upper division program when completing the last semester of prerequisite coursework.
